### **School Watch**

# School Watch is a programme of support which ensures your child achieves their full potential and thrives at school. If you are eligible for <u>Pupil Premium</u> funding then your child will automatically get a place on the School Watch programme.

Every child is different. To allow us to work with your child in the most effective way possible we have created 5 different sections to the School Watch programme. Each section will allow us to work alongside you and your child in a way that has your child's best interests as top priority. A child who is already doing well academically at school can still be eligible for the School Watch programme. In these cases we will look at what else we can do for your child to allow them to grow and excel.



## Homework Watch

Homework Watch allows us to work closely with you, your child and the class teacher to ensure that all homework is completed to the best of your child's ability. This will include support for:

- weekly menu homework
- spellings
- daily reading
- times tables practise
- generally enhancing links between home and school.



### **Progress Watch**

Progress Watch allows us to work closely with you, your child and the class teacher to provide academic support to ensure that your child is making the expected level of progress in all subjects. We can identify areas for development and then look at ways in which we can support this within school through:

- team teaching
- small group booster support
- 1 to 1 support



# **Achievement Watch**

Achievement Watch is for children who are already achieving the level we would expect for their age. This programme allows us to make sure that your child does not simply stand still but aims to achieve as much as they possibly can. This may include:

- small group work to provide extension activities
- team teaching with a focus on extending the more able children
- organising opportunities for a child to achieve in other areas of the curriculum such as art, music, sport where they show a particular talent.
- character education work which looks at setting and achieving goals, raising expectations



#### **Emotional Watch**

Emotional Watch allows us to work with your child to provide them with emotional support to deal with anxieties, grief, self-belief, confidence as well as supporting any child with behavioural issues which arise both within and outside school. This may include:

- ELSA working with our Emotional Literacy Support Assistant
- 1 to 1 sessions to develop strategies for behaviour management
- small group sessions to deal with a variety of emotions, situations
- Home school links to transfer strategies used within school to the home environment



#### **Engagement Watch**

Engagement Watch is for those children who we feel are not as engaged with school life as we would like them to be. This will allow us to work closely with yourself and your child to develop motivation, self-belief and a sense of enthusiasm to promote a positive attitude towards school life and learning. This may include:

- organising opportunities to try new activities and develop new skills
- character education work
- close monitoring and recognition when achievements have been made to raise self-esteem.

We will work closely with you at all times and strongly believe that the School Watch programme will be the most effective when it is a 3 way process between your child, yourself and the school. We are committed to ensuring your child thrives at school.
