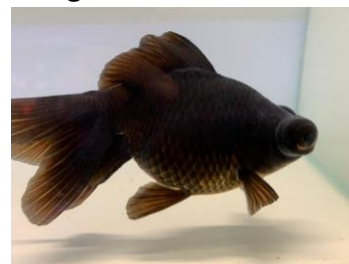
Our fish has grown too big for his tank. Do you have an old tank that you no longer need and wouldn't mind donating it to class 3? It needs to be bigger than:


